

HOUSE OF REGNAVANT

FORTY-FIVE DAYS

IN PLACE OF THREE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-TWO

We absorbed the three hundred and twenty-two days customarily spent examining a technology asset. Carried in full, on this side, before an invitation was ever issued. A delay of that length is named a grievance by those who bear it, and its relief is the obligation of the house, not a courtesy.

We hold a window of forty-five days. Not a shortened examination. What remains once the work those days are spent on is already complete, dated, sealed, and available for review by the acquirer's own specialists. **The time was carried at the back of the house so the front of it could be brief.**

Findings updated annually and held on file.

*** Technology-intensive transactions: 322 days.**

The acquirer engages thirty to forty outside parties. *To establish what is true.*

Then pays a second time for the property itself. *The preparation was never the guest's to carry.*

A plate does not leave the pass until it is right. *No one is called to the kitchen to confirm it.*

You are informed when it is ready. *Each system keeps its own showroom, and the acquirer holds the key before the first meeting.*

The road was already laid by the bodies that publish. The house had only to walk it:

FIPS 180-4	Secure Hash Standard. The hash beneath every sealed record.
FIPS 186-5	Digital Signature Standard. The classical signature, published 3 February 2023.
FIPS 204 / 205	Post-quantum signature standards. Effective 14 August 2024, carried beside the classical one. The federal civilian clock runs to 2030 and 2031; this migration is already behind the house.
RFC 8785	Canonicalisation. The bytes are the house's own, identical in both languages.
RFC 6962	Append-only transparency structure. Inclusion and consistency proofs your specialists may recompute.
RFC 3161	Trusted timestamping. The published protocol for attesting that a record existed at a stated time.
W3C VC 2.0	Open credential format. The standalone checker issues a verifiable credential, importing nothing of ours.
17 U.S.C. § 102	Registration of the work. Filed with the United States Copyright Office before the first invitation.
§ 347.061 RSMo	Property of company, title. Property held in the company's name is the company's. It travels inside the conveyance, not beside it.

Every standard above was published, dated, and in force long before this house existed. None required a private party's permission; the road was already laid. Each was met, and each was passed — carried further than the text requires, and carried earlier than the transaction asks. **The examination those three hundred and twenty-two days pay for was completed against the published text in advance, and may be repeated by the acquirer's own specialists without this house in the room.**

We lead with proof. That's the baseline.
